

Eco Collage & Colour Bag

You will need:

- Berol Fabric Pens
- Berol Marvin Medium Glue
- Berol Handwriting Pencil
- Hard, flat work surface
- Iron
- Wide masking tape
- Canvas bags
- Glue spatulas
- Collage material from magazines and newspapers
- A4 construction paper

What to do?

1. Use an iron to smooth the canvas before beginning this activity if the bag has creases across it.
2. Lay the bag onto a hard, flat surface and secure by taping the top edge to the work surface.
3. Pressing lightly with a pencil, draw the design outline onto the fabric. Decide where to use the fabric pens and where the collage material will be glued down.
4. Colour in areas of the design using Berol fabric pens.
5. Seal the design using an iron on low temperature. Follow the instructions on the Berol fabric pen box.
6. Once the fabric pen part of the design is sealed, insert a folded piece of A4 paper into the bag. To prevent the glue from sticking the bag together.
7. Rip and cut magazine clippings into small pieces.
8. Collage this material onto the bag by using a thin layer of Marvin Medium glue.
9. Ensure that the collage material is completely stuck down by adding a thin layer of Marvin Medium glue to the surface.
10. The great thing about the glue is that it dries clear and can be wiped clean.



Additional Information

Discuss the importance of using canvas bags when shopping and why it is important to relay this message to others by using a specially designed canvas bag.

Think about slogans in our everyday lives that catch our attention. Can you make up your own? Can you design an eco-symbol for your bag that will catch people's attention?
